2	Tallero Prosecco, Italy	200ml bottle		£7.50
	Fresh and aromatic nose of green apples and minerals. Crisp, fruity, dry and elegant, medium bodied with a long, fresh aftertaste.			
3	Champagne Veuve Deloynes Brut NV, France			£45.00
	Full flavoured but not too heavy, made entirely from Pinot Noir grapes.			
4	Champagne Thienot Brut NV, France	375ml bottle		£35.00
	Powerful nose with hints of pipped-fruit jam, apples and quince. Rounded and long on the palate, with a succession of apple and pear, fresh-fruit fragrances. Persistent bead of bubbles with a creamy mousse.

	A crisp, juicy white from the northwest region of Spain. Easy drinking.			
6	Sauvignon Blanc Pacifico Sur, Chile	£3.75	£4.75	£21.00
	Aromas of fresh grapefruit and lime blend with herbs and floral notes. Soft, citric and refreshing on the palate.			
7	Pinot Grigio Il Caggio, Italy	£4.00	£5.00	£22.00
	Flavours of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.			
8	Chardonnay Viognier Les Gres, France			£25.00
	Fresh and aromatic nose of green apples and minerals. Crisp, fruity, dry and elegant, medium bodied with a long, fresh aftertaste.			
9	Sauvignon Blanc Round Stone, New Zealand			£27.00
	Pineapple and freshly cut grass on the nose. Rich on the palate with good texture and fine acidity.			
10	Picpoul de Pinet, Beranger, Les Costieres de Pomerols, France			£28.00
	Aromatic white with floral and citrus notes on the nose. The palate is dry with flavours of lemon peel, grapefruit and white peach.			
11	Macon La Roche-Vineuse, Domaine Normand, Burgundy, France			£33.00
	Plump with notes of pear, almonds and citrus, this mouth filling wine gently unfolds onto the palate finishing with subtle minerality and spice notes.			
12	Sancerre Domaine Ducroux, Loire, France			£38.00
	Crisp and clean with fantastic purity of flavour and elegant mineral tones throughout. Bursting with ripe citrus fruit and supported by a core of zippy acidity. A long, lingering finish.

	Crisp and refreshing flavours of soft red fruits are complemented by subtle floral aromas.

16	Merlot Pacifico Sur, Chile Red berry & plum aromas. More plummy fruit flavours on the palate, a well-balanced wine.	£3.75	£4.75	£21.00
17	Shiraz Cabernet The Landings, Australia Black fruits with slightly spicy flavours, great with red meats and grilled dishes.	£4.00	£5.00	£22.00
18	Rioja Tinto Sonsierra, Spain Aromas of orange peel and dried fruit along with spicy notes from new wood. Robust and fruity with pleasing tannins and a long pleasant finish.			£25.00
19	Malbec 'Chacabuco' Los Haroldos, Argentina Medium bodied and well balanced. Smoky tannins support raspberry, plum and cassis flavours alongside a healthy dose of aromatic wood and spice.			£27.00
20	Grace Bridge Pinot Noir, Brownstone Winery, USA Lovely flavours of ripe cherry and raspberry mix well with tasty spice and underlying earthy tones that really flesh this wine out.			£31.00
21	Fleurie Montangeron, Beaujolais, France Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. Soft blackcurrant and subtle violet notes throughout lead to long silky finish.			£33.00
22	Chateau Maurac Cru Bourgeois Haut Medoc, Bordeaux, France Mature with dried fruit, peppery spice, grilled meat tobacco and leather flavours on the palate. Drink now and for the next five years.			£38.00

23	Chateau Padouen Sauternes, France A rich, concentrated, golden-coloured Sauternes that has notes of honey, dried apricots and almonds with some tangy acidity to add balance.		£3.95	£30.00
24	Botrytis Riesling, Casas del Bosque, Chile Light golden in colour this complex wine reveals a seductive nose of apricot, crème brûlée, walnut and toasted almond.		£4.25	£32.00

25	Graham's 10 Year Old Tawny Port Deep tawny colour, with a nose that shows complex nutty aromas combined with hints of honey and figs. On the palate, rich mature fruit flavours, beautifully mellowed with a luscious long finished.		£5.00	£50.00
26	Graham's Malvedos Vintage Port Very deep purple colour. On the nose this port is powerful and with great depth of fruit, packed with layers of 'jammy' dark fruits such as cassis and blackberry. On the palate it is full bodied and well structured, with complex flavours of dark fruits and nuances of black chocolate. Excellent balance combined to ripe and firm tannins lead to a prolonged and stylish finish.		£6.50	£70.00
